

Citronella

Citronella (*Pelargonium citrosum* or *Pelargonium graveolens*)



Season: Spring

Annual plant unless protected from cold; good for containers and as houseplants.

Sun Exposure: Full to partial sun

Size: 2–3 ft tall and wide

Blooms: In summer—pink/purple flowers

Maintenance Category: Low; not frost tolerant.

Highlights: It has a lemony scent with lacy leaves, is deer resistant, and can be propagated by cuttings.

How to Use: Ornamental
