

Dill

Dill (*Anethum graveolens*)



Season: Spring (will bolt and go to seed in hot weather)

Annual

Sun Exposure: Full sun or partial shade

Size: up to 4–5 ft tall

Blooms: Clusters of small yellow flowers bloom in late summer

Maintenance Category: Low

Highlights: Has delicate feathery leaves, attracts butterflies and beneficial insects, is a host plant for the Black Swallowtail butterfly; the caterpillar will eat the dill and then form a chrysalis on the plant.

How to Use: Culinary: in making pickles, sauces, dips, butters, and cheeses. It combines well with salmon. It can be used as companion plant with cabbage and broccoli.

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
